


New Entrance





Studio Policies and Procedures

INCLEMENT WEATHER: BSD will not hold classes when Portage Public Schools is closed due to weather. Classes cancelled due to inclement weather <u>will not be rescheduled</u>. Cancellations will be sent out via text (REMIND)/email.

PARENT OBSERVATION: Parents are invited to observe and record their child during "Peek Week". Class observation during regularly scheduled weeks is not available.

TUITION: Tuition amounts are per month: Oct-Dec for Fall '23, Jan-May for Spring '24. Tuition is the same whether the month is 3, 4 or 5 weeks. This evens out over the course of the semester. Please remember tuition does not change due to absence or studio closing for holidays or inclement weather.

Class tuition is paid through Parent Portal (DSP) on the 1st of the month. All automatic payments process on the 3rd of each month. Late fees are applied after end of day on the 3rd of the month at \$5.00 per week. All tuition and costume balances must be paid in full prior to recital in order for dancer to participate.

**Monthly automatic payments will be processed for the entire balance on the account each month (including costume fees, etc.)

COSTUMES: Plan to budget around \$65.00 (plus tax) per dance class (that perform) for recital costumes along with \$10 (plus tax) for recital tights. Recital costumes and tights are ordered at the beginning of the semester. Once costumes are ordered, they are **non-refundable**.

RECITAL: Recital tickets will go on sale about 1 month prior to recital. Plan to budget around \$12 per ticket per show. We will have 2-3 shows and each class performs a total of twice throughout the shows.

WITHDRAWAL: Once registration closes for a term there is a one-month notice is required to discontinue any payments for the following month. To withdraw, a parent must email staff@bsodance.com to inform us of the withdrawal request. Autopay charges will stop after the one-month notice period.

Studio Policies and Procedures

Note: the FULL BSD Code of Conduct is in the Parent Portal and must be agreed to upon registration. Please look over that in depth with your dancer.

STUDIO ETIQUETTE:

- No street shoes, food or gum are allowed inside the dance studios.
- Water bottles are encouraged to bring to class and must be filled with WATER ONLY.
- Please be respectful of all BSD furniture and property, the studio is not a playground.
- It is ok to bring food or snacks into the lobby or dancer area, please be sure to clean up after yourself!
- Dancers may not tap dance in the lobby area while waiting for class to start.
- The studio design allows for multiple classes to be held simultaneously. Please be respectful of the other classes and refrain from activities that may be distracting to the participants/instructors and keep the noise level to a minimum.

CLASSROOM ETIQUETTE:

- Dancers should arrive a few mins prior to class in order to put on the proper dance shoes before entering the classroom so class can begin promptly.
- We are here to learn dance and have fun.
- Dancers must be respectful of their instructors and use class time appropriately.
- BSD does **NOT** tolerate any type of bullying. Leave gossip at the door!

ATTIRE: Dancers must be dressed appropriately to participate in class and have hair pulled back. Dancers should wear form fitting clothes (i.e.)...leotards, tights with the option of "extras" over top for certain classes. See full Attire Requirements page for specific class listing.

SICKNESS: In the event that your dancer is sick please use your best judgement when deciding to send them to class or not. If your dancer has a fever we recommend refraining from sending them until they are fever free for 24hrs. Please contact staff to inform us of any absences. If your dancer would like to make up studio time, please contact us for available classes.

ATTENDANCE: Having good attendance is important to the progression of the dancer, as each week skills are taught that build on the previous week's skills and choreography. Dancers with poor attendance slow the advancement of the class and inhibit personal growth. If regular attendance is not met in required technique classes teachers reserve the right to dismiss dancer from corresponding recital dance.

Studio Policies and Procedures

RESCHEDULING, SUBSTITUTE CLASS AND TEACHERS:

- BSD reserves the right to reschedule or combine classes as necessary.
- BSD reserves the right to provide a substitute or replacement teacher as BSD may deems necessary.

COMMUNICATIONS: Every other Sunday, we will send out our "Studio News" electronic newsletter. Our newsletter will include all important up-to-date information regarding the studio including dates, activities and more. We also utilize **Remind** for timely notifications (studio closings, class cancellations, etc.) and **Google Classroom and Calendar**. Look for an invite to join Remind early in the semester. Google Classroom (join here: https://classroom.google.com/c/NTIzMzk3Mjk1Njc5?cjc=jmepzws) allows families/dancers to access updated videos of their choreography for continued practice at home or in the case of absences, along with resources and important information. All important dates including any class makeups etc will always be up to date on the Classroom's Calendar.
